New text:	“Adopting position papers”
Reasoning:	<p>IGLYO has made position papers yearly since 2011 and as of today have six position papers on all from Education to Health. These have all been approved by the General Assembly, still these are not regulated not mentioned in any internal regulation nor statutes. This makes it difficult to understand the role of the position papers within the organizational framework of IGLYO, meaning there is no structured thinking of when they need to be updated, how long they last or that they even exist.</p> <p>Adding them to the statutes is acknowledging the existence of these documents that line out the stance of IGLYO on fundamental topics in relation to the aims of the organization.</p> <p>Therefore it is suggested that that this added to the list of competencies of the General Assembly in the statutes, in line with strategic plan and work plan, giving them greater legitimacy.</p> <p>It is the Board’s intention to later add them to the Internal Regulations so that they may be developed and renewed to meet the challenges of tomorrow.</p>
