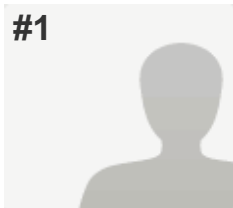

Q4: Please tell us about your motivation to host the next IGLYO Annual Members Conference.

LGBT Youth Scotland would love to be considered as the host organisation for IGLYO's Annual Members Conference in 2018 because:

- 2018 is designated the 'Year of Young People' by the Scottish Government and as such will bring opportunities to raise the profile of and provide a warm welcome to delegates from around Europe and further afield;
- Young people, staff and volunteers at LGBT Youth Scotland want to demonstrate solidarity with LGBTI people in Europe and internationally, particularly as the UK prepares to leave the European Union;
- Scotland would be ranked the top country in Europe for LGBT equality, if it were ranked separately, though the UK was ranked third in ILGA-Europe's Rainbow Europe Map of LGBT rights.

Q5: Please tell us about your organisation's experience of hosting large events.

LGBT Youth Scotland successfully hosted the IGLYO General Assembly in 2009. We regularly hold training conferences and events for young people with 100+ participants, including residential events over several days. The charity has a strong network of partnerships in the private, public and third sectors in Scotland, who could be called upon as partners, including Visit Scotland and the Scottish Government, who would be able to help with the informal elements of the programme.

Q6: Please tell us about your experience of fundraising for projects and events.

LGBT Youth Scotland has an annual income of approx. £1 million and has an ongoing programme of fundraising activity from voluntary income, grants and trusts and public bodies. We are a strategic partner of the Scottish Government, as an equality organisation and national voluntary youth organisation, helping deliver the Scottish Government's objectives for LGBTI equality and for young people in Scotland. We have managed and promoted LGBT History Month for the past ten years and successfully had a programme of events funded, including one off events and a cultural programme.

Q7: Please list all potential funding applications/grants/other sources of income you have identified to co-fund the Annual Members Conference with estimated amounts for each. Host organisations are expected to raise around €8.000 - €12.000.

Q8: Please tell us what staff/volunteer resources you have available to assist with the planning and running of the Annual Members Conference.

If successful, LGBT Youth Scotland would assign a senior manager at LGBT Youth Scotland to lead on the project management and fundraising in planning for the event. In addition, youth work staff and volunteers would be available to join the IGLYO staff and volunteer team in the smooth running of the event in Scotland. In addition, we would be able to draw on partnerships to welcome and host international delegates.

LGBT Youth Scotland would like to see some exploration of the direct impact on LGBTI young people here in Scotland of the organisation hosting the event and will be an enthusiastic and willing partner of IGLYO.
