To ensure a democratic process in the election of the Board an Election Committee should be added. The Election Committee should have the task of making sure a wide range of nominations are collected before the AMC to make sure that the candidates for the board are competent, diverse and reflect our community. In the processing of the nominations the Election Committee can use a competence-based method to enable all candidates to show their full capacity. Having another body in the Association than the Board preparing the nominations would facilitate a more transparent and democratic process.

Addition Paragraph (13) “(13) (m) Electing members of the Electing Committee”

Addition: Paragraph (28)

“(28) The General Assembly will choose 3-7 persons as the Election Committee at the AMC.

- a) The mandate of the Election Committee runs for 1 year.
- b) The role of the Election Committee is to process and prepare the nominations for the Board to the General Assembly to vote on the next AMC.
- c) The Election Committee may prepare a suggestion of a Board to the General Assembly to vote on at the AMC, nominations outside of the suggestion will still be eligible as candidates. The Election Committee will take into consideration marginalized and intersecting identities of the nominees to make sure the suggestion for the Board is diverse and representative.
- d) The Election Committee can also submit independent motions or suggestions to be discussed and voted on by the General Assembly at the AMC.”
