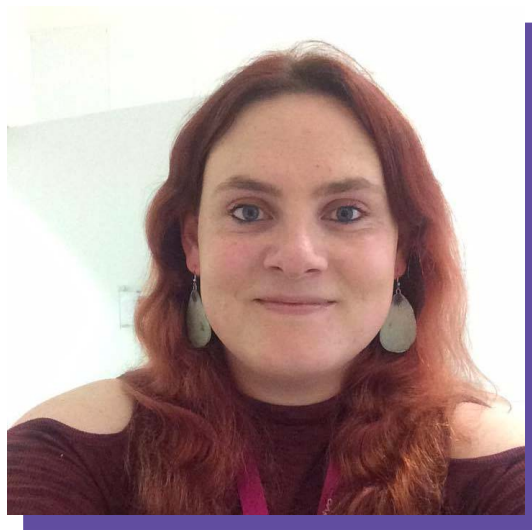

## New board members

New board member candidates had to receive 30%+1 of all valid votes to be elected. This year, we welcomed Toryn Glavin (she) (ITSA, Ireland) and Erin Vlahović (he) (Trans Aid, Croatia). Their mandates will run from 2020 – 2022. We received 55 votes in total, with 1 MO organisation that skipped the vote. Toryn received 46 votes (83.64%) and Erin received 52 votes (94.55%), which means both candidates managed to get over 30%+1 required to be elected as a board member. Welcome to both!

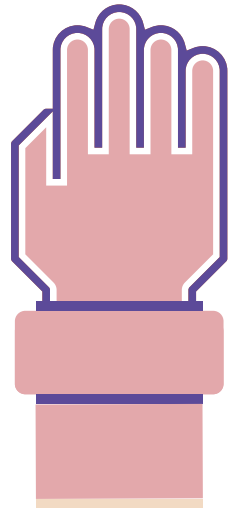
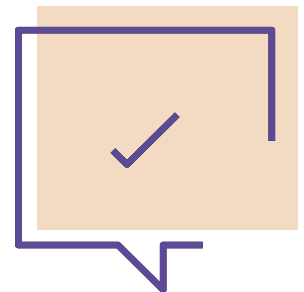
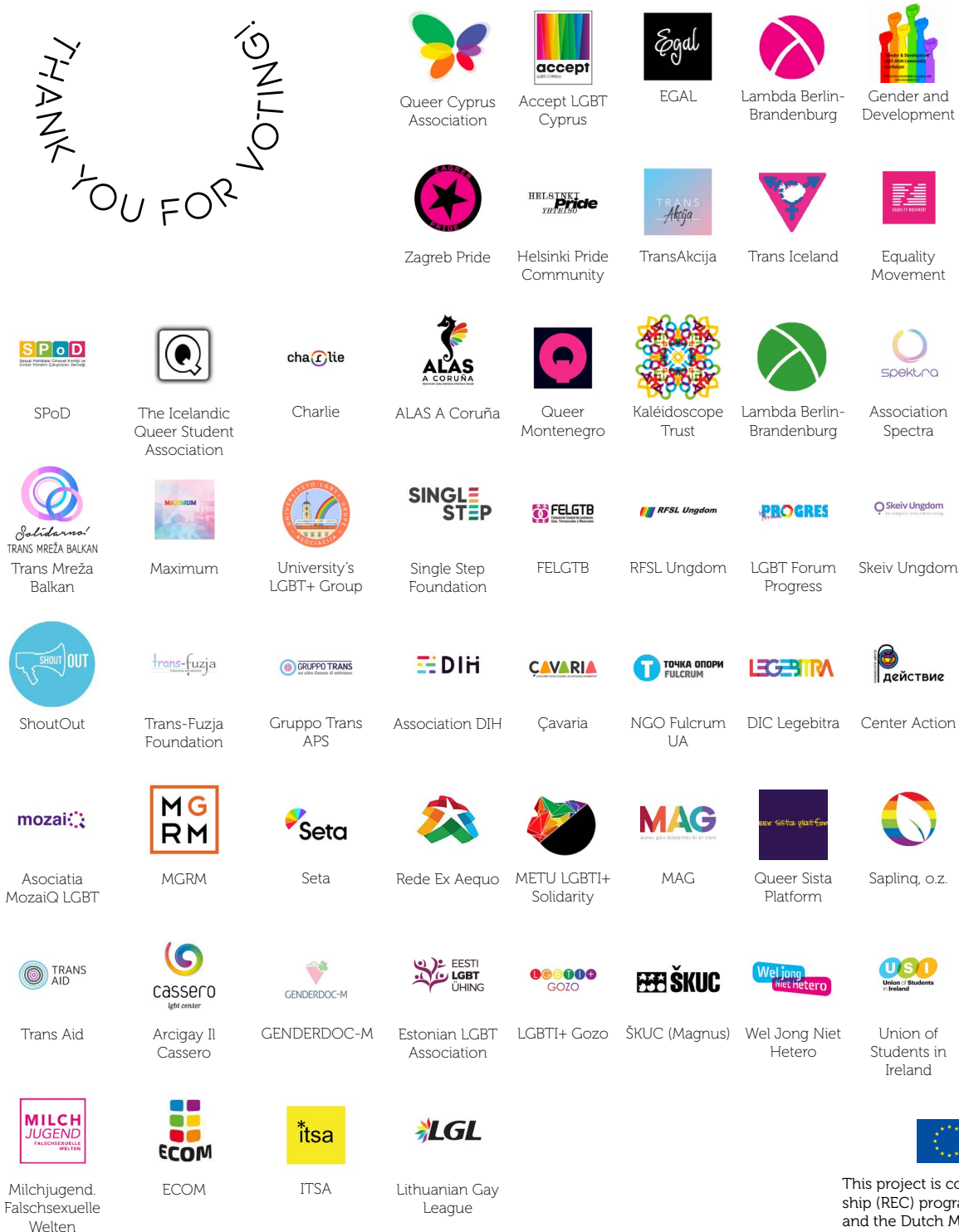
